Mr. Saif-ul-Rehman, the head teacher of Govt. Primary School 206 RB-IV has been working in this position since the past 02 years and has done his best to enrol students both boys and girls to promote ‘parha likha Punjab’ or EFA under very trying conditions. After a bitter struggle he succeeded in mobilizing two kanals of land.

Due to lack of facilities, it is impossible to improve the quality of education. People flock towards education at all costs for improving their children’s future as a means for improved well being. The School 206 RB-IV reveals community’s commitment to children’s education. But the desperate conditions of the school cannot be ignored any longer.

The school's enrolment dips after katchi from 42 to 24 in C1, and rising to 32 in C-III, and only 18 in C-V, highlighting high levels of internal inefficiency.

The headteacher is doing his best to promote education at all costs but the odds are all stacked against him inspite of 162 children due to abysmal physical learning environment and facilities.

The school could benefit from partnerships for improvement. The Public Private Partnership Policy 2004 was passed by the Government of Faisalabad to improve its facilities. The Government of Punjab has openly called for public private partnerships as a development strategy in areas where economic growth is promising around industrial and high producing agricultural clusters.

Faisalabad has the unique privilege of being called the 'Manchester of Pakistan' on the one hand and also being associated with high value added agricultural production. The district is blessed with leadership with a vision, determined to reduce poverty, through education and improved social services. Khurrianwala bordering between Faisalabad city and Jaranwala Tehsil is one such industrial cluster with a very impressive list of industrial houses that are not just pioneers of industry but also committed to building social capital and human resources. They care for their children and their future.
