What can I do with one teacher/myself in a primary school with six classes? Exclaims the only teacher . “At least one more teacher is essential even to run multi-grade school! I have a major shortage of building. The class-IV support staff is very essential ” said Talib Hussain, the senior teacher of Govt. Primary School, 75 RB-II. Mr.Talib has been in this position from the past 22 years! He has done his best to enrol students so that the dream of ‘parha likha Punjab’ may come true for this area...for him it is a losing battle!

The school has an enrolment of 55 students with just one teacher. The challenge of delivering quality with a pupil teacher ratio of 55:1 is impossible. You can understand what will be happen if he falls sick or has to visit the department for official work. People flock towards education at all costs for improving their children’s future as a means to better prospects in the future. School 75 RB–II, reveals the community’s commitment to children education. Amidst persistent hopes for education, the desperate conditions of the school cannot be ignored any longer.

The school has a enrolment of 55 students. with a maximum of 16 children in class III and only 5 in class I with just one teacher.

The matric PTC teacher has never been trained in mulit-grade training and is desperate to improve conditions. The physical learning environment is totally depleted.

The school could benefit from partnerships for improvement. The Public Private Partnership Policy 2004 was passed by the Government of Faisalabad to improve its facilities.
