The school has an enrolment of 429 students. In spite of support by Mian Jalil an expatriate Pakistani living in USA and with his commitment to education improvement in the district, the school has several unmet needs. The expatriate community needs to be tapped for more support. People from the community flock towards education at all costs for improving their children’s future as a means to better prospects in the future. School GGES 56 JB reveals the community’s commitment to children education. Amidst persistent hopes for education, the desperate conditions of the school cannot be ignored any longer.

The school has a sharp downward enrolment curve from Katchi to class 1. 78 are enrolled in Prep, 40 in class 1, rising to 40 in C-II, stabilising to 64 C-III, 58 C-IV, 68 C-V. The enrolment dips again in the middle grades to 36 in C-V, C-VI 31, C-VII, 33 and for C VIII- 21 highlighting high levels of internal inefficiency. This is not due to lack of interest and skills by the head teacher and teachers, but due to a very poor physical learning environment and severe shortage of facilities.

The school could benefit from partnerships for improvement. The Public Private Partnership Policy 2004 was passed by the Government of Faisalabad to improve its facilities. The Government of Punjab has openly called for public private partnerships as a development strategy in areas where economic growth is promising around industrial and high producing agricultural clusters.

Faisalabad has the unique privilege of being called the 'Manchester of Pakistan' on the one hand and also being associated with high value added agricultural production. The district is blessed with leadership with a vision, determined to reduce poverty, through education and improved social services.

Faisalabad is one such industrial cluster with a very impressive list of industrial houses who are not just pioneers of industry but also committed to building social capital and human resources. They care for their children and their future.
