Girls High School Allama Iqbal Colony Faisalabad. She has done her best to enrol students and for the betterment of the school, so that the dream of ‘Para likha Punjab’ may come true for this area. Coca Cola funded improvement in this school tremendously but it needs more work. The Pupil teacher ratio is 48:1 and pupil classroom ratio is 76:1

The school has an enrolment of 1528 students. With lack of manpower and facilities, it is impossible to improve the quality of education. People flock towards education at all costs for improving their girls’ future as a means to better prospects in the future. GGHS Allama Iqbal Colony reveals the community’s commitment to children education. Amidst persistent hopes for education, the desperate conditions of the school cannot be ignored any longer.

The school has an enrolment in class prep 142, class I 104, class II 104, class III 84, class VI 103 and in class V 102. The school manages to enrol 238 children in class VI with 215 in class VIII dropping off to 115 in class X highlighting a high levels of internal efficiency.

There is a need to improve the physical condition of the school with higher number of teachers

The school could benefit from partnerships for improvement. The Public Private Partnership Policy 2004 was passed by the Government of Faisalabad to improve its facilities. The Government of Punjab has openly called for public private partnerships as a development strategy in areas where economic growth is promising around industrial and high producing agricultural clusters.

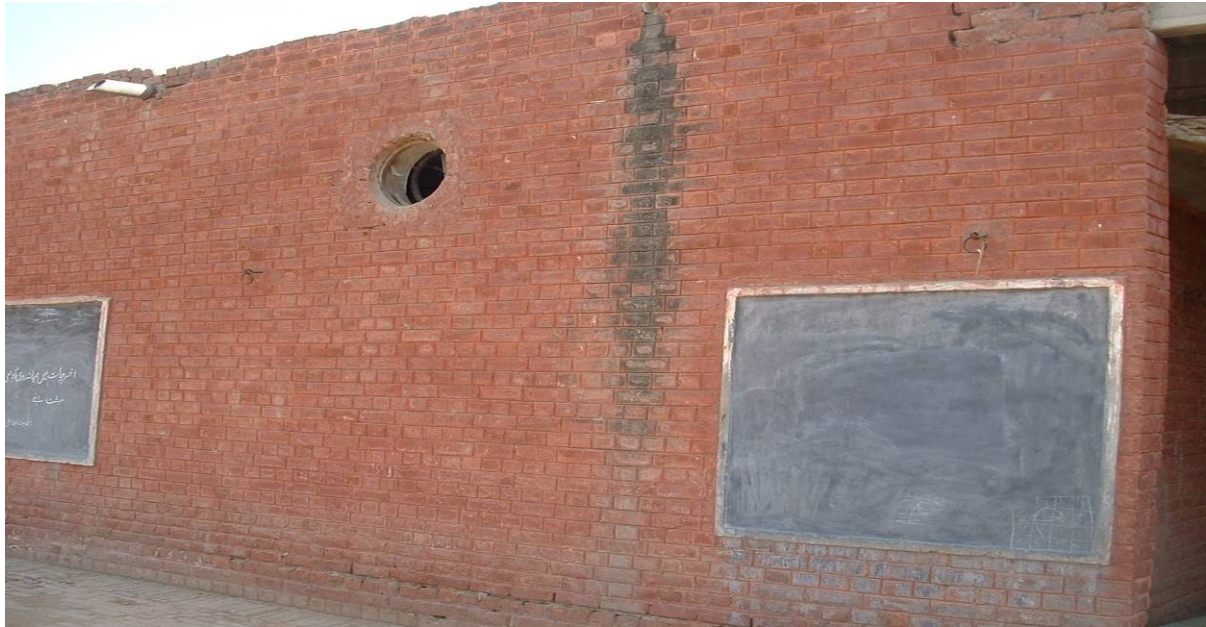
