The school has an enrolment in class prep 15, class 1 27, class II 30, class III 18, class VI 13 and in class V 23 , highlighting high levels of internal inefficiency. This is not due to lack of interest and skills by the head teacher and teachers, but due to a very poor physical learning environment and severe shortage of facilities.

The school could benefit from partnerships for improvement. The Public Private Partnership Policy 2004 was passed by the Government of Faisalabad to improve its facilities. The Government of Punjab has openly called for public private partnerships as a development strategy in areas where economic growth is promising around industrial and high producing agricultural clusters.

Faisalabad has the unique privilege of being called the 'Manchester of Pakistan' on the one hand and also being associated with high value added agricultural production.
