Averages hide! The real pupil teacher ratio is not 86:1 but more like 175 students to 1 teacher in class X and 204 students in class XI! This is truly shocking! And teachers hold their classes with the help of a microphone! Children sit in the open, under tents, shelters in way they can as this is a precious higher secondary school, which are so few in the country. The student classroom ratio is even more shocking with 20 room and 3720 or 1: 186 or one classroom to 186 students! “We need furniture for students and teachers, We need 15 classrooms, and extra Toilets and 30 Teachers said Mrs.Kalsoom Akhtar” the Principal of. MC Girls Higher Secondary School Samanabad Faisalabad. She has been in this position for the last three years and has done her best to enrol students so that the dream of ‘Parha likha Punjab’ may come true for this area, and especially for girls. However what is a greater challenge is the inability of the headteacher to spend 4.7 million rupees for providing facilities to the school that the school so desperately deserves.

The school has an enrolment of 3720 students with 43 teachers but is short on many facilities with just 20 classrooms for 3720 students and five being repairable. Girls H/SS Samanabad reveals the community’s commitment to education. 3720 girls are enrolled at high and higher secondary levels amidst persistent hopes for education. The desperate conditions of the school cannot be ignored any longer.

The school has an enrolment of 672 in class VI, 553 in Class VII, 541 in Class VIII, 734 in Class IX, 445 in Class X, 382 in class XI and 393 in class XII. The enrolment is high at all levels with some
This is not due to lack of interest and skills by the head teacher and teacher, but due to a very poor physical learning environment.
