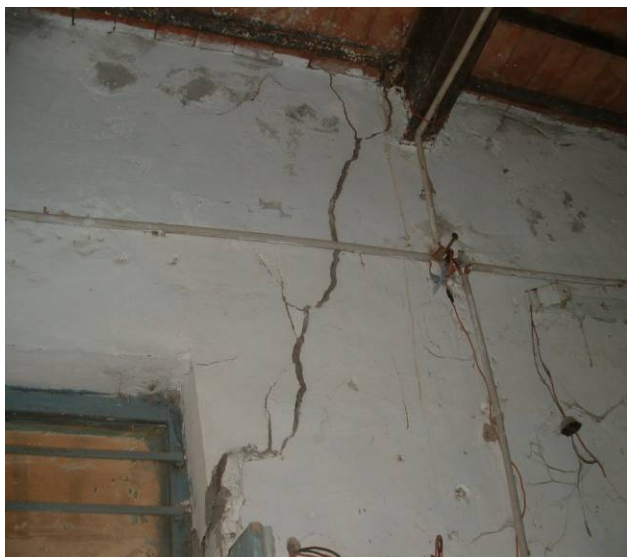


**Wanted Partnerships for School Improvement: Education at all costs in GHS 105 GB Jaranwala Faisalabad!**

We need one Science teacher, two rooms are highly dangerous said Mr.Bashir Ahmad.”** the Senior Teacher of Govt. High School 105GB JaranwalaFaisalabad .He has been in this position for the last five and half years and has done his best to enrol students so that the dream of ‘Parha likha Punjab’ may come true for this area, and especially for girls.

The school has an enrolment of 622 students with 16 teachers and only 7 classrooms for 11 classes! This can be undertaken today as resources and political will for education continue to escalate in Pakistan and especially Punjab. People flock towards education at all costs for improving their children’s future as a means to better prospects in the future. **GHS 105GB**reveals the community’s commitment to education. 622

boys are enrolled. Amidst persistent hopes for education, the desperate conditions of the school cannot be ignored any longer.

The school has an enrolment of 125 in Prep, dropping in Class I to 75 , in Class II to 60, Class III,55 , Class IV,45 , and in Class, V, to 30. In the middle section it is Class VI ,47, Class VII 47,Class VIII 47,Class IX 49, Class X18, The school has a sharp decline in enrolment from grade Katchi onwards and reducing finally to 18. This is not due to lack of interest and skills by the head teacher and teacher, but due to a very poor physical learning environment.

The school could benefit from partnerships for improvement. The Public Private Partnership Policy 2004 was passed by the Government of Faisalabad to improve its facilities. The Government of Punjab has openly called for public private partnerships as a development strategy in areas where economic growth is promising around industrial and high producing agricultural clusters.

Faisalabad has the unique privilege of being called the 'Manchester of Pakistan' on the one hand and also being associated with high value added agricultural production. The district is blessed with leadership with a vision, determined to reduce poverty, through education and improved social services.
