GPS 223 RB Kallar Colony, **has** an enrolment of 195 students with 3 teachers. This can be undertaken today as resources and political will for education continues to escalate in Pakistan and especially Punjab. People flock towards education at all costs for improving their children’s future as a means to better prospects in the future reveals the community’s commitment to education. 195 Boys are enrolled. Amidst persistent hopes for education, the desperate conditions of the school cannot be ignored any longer.

The school has an enrolment of 195, 85 in Prep, with a sharp drop of 50 students in Class I, dropping to 23 in Class II, to 17 in Class III, and finally left with only 14 in Class. The admissions are open for the new session. The drop out rate is a challenge due to shortage of teachers and very poor physical conditions not conducive for learning.

The school could benefit from partnerships for improvement. The Public Private Partnership Policy 2004 was passed by the Government of Faisalabad to improve its facilities. The Government of Punjab has openly called for public private partnerships as a development strategy in areas where economic growth is promising around industrial and high producing agricultural clusters.

Faisalabad has the unique privilege of being called the 'Manchester of Pakistan' on the one hand and also being associated with high value added agricultural production. The district is blessed with leadership with a vision, determined to reduce poverty, through education and improved social services.

Faisalabad is one such industrial cluster with a very impressive list of industrial houses that are not just pioneers of industry but also committed to building social capital and human resources. They care for their children and their future.

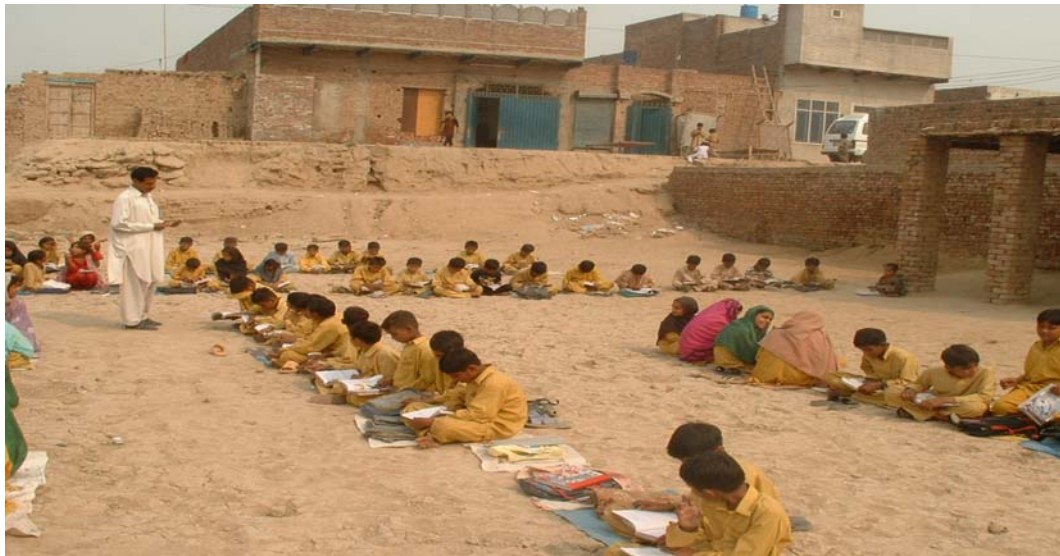
